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#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Concordia University (Saint Paul, MN) Department of Kinesiology & Health Sciences invites applications for a tenure-track position in Kinesiology & Health Sciences at the rank of assistant professor, to begin in August 2012. Applicants must have or be near completion of a Ph.D. in Exercise Science or in a related field such as Sports Management or Applied Health Sciences. ABDs nearing completion of the Ph.D. will be considered with the initial appointment to be made at the rank of instructor.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate a strong commitment to innovative and high quality teaching, show strong potential for productive research/scholarly activities and service to the institution. In accordance with the university mission statement, applicants must also be an active member of a Christian church and demonstrate a commitment to Christian higher education and the Lutheran identity of the university including a willingness to engage in the campus-wide conversation related to faith and learning.

The typical teaching load averages 12 credits per semester and will be made up of courses in general education and the Exercise Science majors (BA, BS MA, MS) and minors. Interest and expertise is required in some of the following coursework: Exercise Physiology, Motor Development/Learning, Sports Management. Faculty members are expected to be comfortable with the use of technology in the classroom and the ability to teach online, face-to-face or in various hybrid pedagogical skills is an advantage. Faculty members are also expected to advise students (undergraduate and graduate), work with the student recruitment process, be involved with the Majors Club and mentor undergraduate and graduate research.

Applications will be reviewed starting January 1, 2012 and accepted until the position is filled. To apply, send a cover letter, curriculum vitae, three letters of recommendation, statement of teaching philosophy, and copies of graduate school transcripts to the address below.
